THE CB PERFORMANCE SCHEME RUNS

1 APRIL –10 OCTOBER

The Scheme is open to UK/EU based, CBHS Registered/overstamped Pure and Part Bred Cleveland Bays. (Note trophies will not be sent out of the UK.)

Points and Bonus Points are awarded according to placing

IN-HAND SHOWING CLASS

Includes all in-hand classes at Local, County and National Shows

Categories:

- Brood Mare
- Foal
- Youngstock (1, 2 & 3 year olds)
- 4 Years and over

Rosettes to 5th place

TROPHY, PRIZE and Commemorative Rosette to the Champion Part Bred
TROPHY, PRIZE and Commemorative Rosette to the Champion Pure Bred

RIDDEN SECTION

Ridden Showing Class

Includes all ridden show classes, eg, riding horse, ridden hunter, cob, hack, sporthorse, ladies hunter etc

Rosettes to 5th place

TROPHY, PRIZE and Commemorative Rosette to the Ridden Showing Champion

Open Ridden Class

Includes working hunter, also eventing, dressage, show jumping, driving, endurance, and sponsored rides with jumps. Points for both affiliated and unaffiliated competitions.

Rosettes to 5th place

TROPHY, PRIZE and Commemorative Rosette to the Open Ridden Champion

TROPHY & PRIZE to OVERALL CHAMPION

SCORING

In order to encourage entries from those with a limited showing/competition

season, participants are to nominate their best six results to represent their entry for this competition. These are to be underlined in red.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1st place5 points
2nd place4 points
3rd place3 points
4th place2 points
5th place1 point

Shows of County and National level carry **DOUBLE POINTS**

Champions and Reserve Champions will be awarded **BONUS POINTS** as follows:

Champion at County or National Shows 15 points
Reserve Champion at County or National Shows10 points
Champion at Local and Agricultural Shows10 points
Reserve Champion at Local and Agricultural Shows 5 points
