Cleveland Bay Horse Society Rules for Artificial Insemination

The Cleveland Bay Horse Society (CBHS) encourages Pure Cleveland Bay foals to be registered where the recipient mare has been inseminated by fresh, chilled or frozen semen provided that the following rules are strictly adhered to:

1 THE DONOR STALLION

The donor Cleveland Bay stallion, as with natural covering, must meet all the requirements of the CBHS for natural service in that it must be:-

- registered with the CBHS and be licensed for Pure breeding.
- DNA analysed and the results recorded on CBHS records.

2 THE SEMEN

The semen used in the insemination must be certified as being the semen of the named donor stallion by a Veterinary Surgeon or such competent person permitted by law in the country where the insemination occurs (see Part B of this document).

3 THE MARE OWNER

The Mare owner must also certify that the semen is from the donor stallion to the best of his/her knowledge and belief.

4 THE RECIPIENT MARE

The recipient mare must meet all of the CBHS requirements for natural service, including:-

- Pure Cleveland Bay mares should be DNA analysed before insemination occurs.
Please check with the CBHS before you proceed with the insemination that your mare is recorded
- **if the mare is not DNA recorded then this simple process will have to be undertaken before a foal can be registered.**

5 THE PROGENY

Any resulting foal must be DNA analysed before they will be accepted for registration into the CBHS stud book and the parentage confirmed.

6 REGISTRATION

All such registrations must be accompanied by this Society's AI certificate fully completed.
