

Cleveland Bay Horse Society

Performance Awards Scheme

This Performance Award scheme is for riders of registered Cleveland Bays (pure and partbred) across a variety of events as listed below for which points will be awarded. If entry numbers allow, the awards will be split between UK and overseas as separate sections, otherwise, all will be judged together.

For Hunting Points, you must have been out for a minimum of **2** hours per Hunt. Hunting Riders may Claim – **30** points per hunt .Hunting points will also be counted separately. (See points chart)

For Hacking/Leisure points to count you must have hacked out for a minimum of **2** hours per 'event' to count Hacking/Leisure Riders may Claim – **20** points per 'event' (This can be accumulated time per week). Hacking / Leisure points will be counted separately. (See points Chart)

For 2022, all points will be based on honesty without requiring signatures of show secretaries, but signatures are preferred where possible..

Entrants who takes part in Breed Demonstrations/Displays may claim – **100** points per Demonstration/Display.

IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR 'UNPLACED' OR 'TOOK PART' POINTS, YOU MUST HAVE COMPLETED THE COMPETITION AND NOT TO HAVE WITHDRAWN, RETIRED OR BEEN DISQUALIFIED.

To be eligible for **Supreme Champion Award**, the horse/pony & rider combination must have competed in at least **three** different disciplines.

ALL entries will receive a Competitor Rosette.

1. The competition shall run from **1st January to 31st December 2022 and points may be claimed retrospectively to start of the year.**
2. Only horses or ponies registered with the CBHS are eligible.
3. Ridden Horses/Ponies must be aged 4yrs or above.
4. **One point's card per horse / pony & rider combination**
5. The scale of points to be awarded is given above.
6. Point's cards are to be **received by** the CBHS Performance Award Secretary by **15th January following the qualifying year**
7. Rosette Awards & Competitor Rosettes will be presented at the CBHS AGM, if possible
8. **Please ensure you have REGISTERED with the CBHS Performance Awards Secretary to be eligible.**

Special Rosette Awards

- **Supreme Champion Horse or Pony.** Most points in total -must include 3 types of activity. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Overall Senior Champion** – To the highest placed adult member, over 18 years. Same Combination of horse/rider
- **Overall Junior Champion** –. To the highest placed member aged 5 to 18 years. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Have- A- Go Champion** – To the highest placed member based only on Unplaced points only. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Dressage Champion** – To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in dressage classes only. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Show Jumping Champion** - To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in Show Jumping and CT classes only. Same Combination of horse/rider
- **Cross Country Champion** - To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in Cross Country and ODE classes only. Same Combination of horse/rider
- **Driving Champion**- To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in harness events only. Same Combination of horse/whip
- **Endurance Champion**- To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in endurance/ pleasure rides only. Same Combination of horse/rider
- **Horse Sports Champion**- To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in horse sports/ vaulting/ working equitation events only. Same Combination of horse/rider
- **Mature Rider Champion**– To the highest placed member aged 60 years or over. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Veteran Champion** – To the **highest placed** mature horse or pony who still enjoys life aged 18 or over. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Hunting Champion** - To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points for the Hunting season only. Same Combination of horse/rider
- **Hunting Rosette Award** – To have hunted for a minimum of 10 hours for the season. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Hacking /Leisure Rosette Award** – To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in leisure use only. Same Combination of horse/rider.
- **Side Saddle Award**- To the highest placed horse or pony gaining the most points in events ridden side saddle (to be noted on points card)
- **Versatility Award**- to horse with points gained in the most types of events. In the event of equality of events, the entrant with the highest overall points will win.

Registration

In order to register horse/pony & rider combination for the Awards, an **entry fee of £10.00 per horse/pony & rider combination for CBHS members and £15 for non members & is payable in advance or with entry submission.** Please make cheques payable to CBHS and send to the office at The Cleveland Bay Horse Society, PO Box 298, CROOK, DL14 4GT or use our PayPal account to 'make a donation' on the CBHS website and include the name of the horse/pony & rider **each** combination and email the awards secretary to register your entry. Once notification and payment have been **received** then your 2021 submission will be valid.
